- 10.5 Dr. Patnaik suggested to write 'Prerequisites'
- 10.6 Dr. Patnaik suggested to add concepts of Analog in syllabus as it is essential in military
- 10.7 Prof. Andurkar suggested to change name of subject 'Digital electronics' to 'Analog and Digital Electronics'
- 10.8 Dr. Patnaik suggested to write 'Using Open source compiler' instead of 'GCC'
- 10.9 Dr. Patnaik suggested to re-draft the topic 'Array and Pointer' as it is repeated in subject 'Data structure fundamentals'
- 10.10 Dr. Patnaik suggested to add 'Hangerian Notation' in syllabus of 'Object Oriented technology'
- 10.11 In practical number 4 of Group A of 'Data structure fundamentals lab', Dr. Patnaik suggested to modify 'database' to 'database using structure'

- 10.20 Dr. Patnaik suggested to remove word 'Study' in practicals and Prof. Gaikwad suggested to write 'Learn and Execute' on its place in 'Software Lab I'
- 10.21 Dr. Patnaik suggested to write full form of 'STL' in practicals 2 and 3 of Group B of 'Object Oriented Lab'
- 10.22 Dr. Patnaik suggested that in note,do not specify 'GCC' and 'except practical 2 and 3 from group dfsfsB' and instead write 'Open source compiler' of Group B of 'Object Oriented Technology Lab.'

Item No 11:



BoS members were not satisfied with present placement.


