NOTICE REGARDING ESE EXAMINATION CONDUCTION

(For FINAL YEAR B.Tech/M.Tech STUDENTS OF AY 2019-20 and Failed Final year students of Earlier batches)

Preamble and References

As we all know that due to COVID -19 pandemic whole world, including India, is passing through unprecedented difficult times. In view of this, guidelines are already issued by various authorities as per the following Circulars/ references:

- 1. Government of Maharashtra (Number 2020/123/3/Dated 08 May 2020, 03 Sept 2020)
- 2. KBCNMU, Jalgaon circular (Number 160/2020 Dated 15 May 2020)
- KBCNMU, Jalgaon circular (Number 7-a//2245/2020 Dated 08 Sept 2020 and 10 September 2020 and Number 7-a/2364/2020 Dated 12 sept 2020)
- 4. An online meeting of all Deans, Heads, Pre-CoE, Post-CoE, CoE held on 08/09/2020
- 5. MoM of online meeting of Examination Committee (12th meeting) of the institute held on 14th Sept, 2020
- 6. MoM of online meeting of Academic Council (12th meeting) of the institute held on 16th Sept, 2020.

Examination to be conducted

1 ESE of Theory and Lab courses will be conducted for 8th semester students with their backlogs of B.Tech (i.e. backlog courses of 5th, 6th 7th) and M.Tech students (Dissertation and Backlog courses).

2 ESE of Theory and Lab courses of B.Tech and M.Tech Final year students of earlier batches who have backlogs courses of (5th 6th 7th or 8thsem) will be conducted.

- 3 ISE-II and Self-study (Remaining Internal examinations) of 8th semester students are also being conducted.
- 4 A Single Re-examination will be conducted for students failed in ESE as mentioned in serial no 1 (Ref no 3) immediately after declaration of ESE examination result.
- 5 All the above examinations rules are applicable to this academic year 2019-20 only due to covid-19 situation

Instructions for ESE of Laboratory Courses

- 1 The viva-voce examinations of Laboratory Courses will be conducted by using online tools like Google meet, Web-Ex platform, Zoom etc. It may also be conducted via telephone in case of difficulty in conducting online mode.
- 2 Project examinations will be conducted through online demonstration or power point presentation or oral. Final soft copy (pdf) of Project reports should be submitted before the examination to the respective department
- 3 The syllabus for the Laboratory Courses is up to the Laboratory courses conducted till **13 Mar 2020**. Also if any Laboratory Courses conducted after 13 Mar via online mode can be kept for viva.
- 4 Industrial lectures / Industrial visit evaluation shall be done as per structure in online mode by concerned department

Instructions for ESE Theory Examinations

- 1 Examination should be conducted in **online mode** through **online examination software** The Syllabus for the eighth semester courses is that taught up to 13 March 2020 inclusive of self study which is displayed on Institute Website, Department website, WhatsApp group ,Social media
- 2 Students shall make arrangement themselves to be equipped with Smartphone/laptop/desktop/tab with webcam along with proper internet connectivity.
- 3 For backlog courses of 5th, 6th 7th semester B.Tech and I year M.tech students examination will be conducted on **COMPLETE SYLLABUS of the course**
- 4 The examination will be in **Multiple Choice Question types (MCQ)** for ESE Examination
- 5 ESE Question paper will be of 60 questions each of one mark having duration of 90 minutes (one and Half hour) for ESE of 60 Marks in the curriculum structure.

- 6 ESE Question paper will be of 30 questions each of one mark having duration of 60 minutes (one hour duration) for ESE of 30 Marks in the curriculum structure.
- 7 No negative marking in ESE examination.
- 8 No rechecking or revaluation or photocopy for online examinations.
- 9 Exam fees Reduction due to COVID-19 situation will be put forth before the BoG and subject to approval by BoG, the exam.fee is reduced by 40%.
- 10 Notice / Timetables of examination shall be displayed on notice boards, institute website and Whats-App.
- 11 Separate instructions regarding online software will be issued.
- 12 For any help / difficulties / grievances regarding examination, students should contact AEC office email ID.
